
Rockford Area Economic Development Council COVID-19 Manufacturers Survey

The Rockford Area Economic Development Council conducted a survey of its regional companies on the impact of COVID-19. The survey was available to be completed from March 17th through March 23rd.


What industries do you provide products or services to?






How long would your company be able to withstand a drastic reduction in revenue?




Do you anticipate losing any business to out of state competitors if additional restrictions are imposed by the State of Illinois?



- Smoother communication and unified voice on the Shelter-In-Place procedure - extending to statewide and a longer time period.


Is your company taking active measures to alleviate the spread of the COVID-19 within the work place environment?

- Allowing work from home.


